2020 in Review

- Covid-19 restrictions drastically shortened our riding season and the cut the number of participants by half.
- KFTHC after enacting safety policies and taking other measures to decrease risk, only offered services from July 27 through October 31.
- 20 KFTHC volunteers provided 190 sessions of Equine Assisted Activities to 22 Individuals from the greater Madison County area.
- KFTHC provided 41 hours of Equine Assisted Activities to United States Veterans and their families
- KFTHC Hosted two Work Study students from Eastern Kentucky University during 2020.
- KFTHC received a \$1003.00 Equipment Grant from the Professional Association of Therapeutic Horsemanship, Intl to purchase equipment for the Veterans' Program.
- KFTHC received a \$1000.00 Service Grant from the Professional Association of Therapeutic Horsemanship, Intl. to provide services to the Veterans in KFTHC's "Equine Services for Heroes Program.
